

RECREATION - PLUS PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Participation in this program is not a right; it is a privilege.

1. Everyone is treated with respect

Use positive language - no swearing
Other peoples things need permission to use - no borrowing without asking
Clean up your own messes - we don't have a maid
Be kind to one another - always think about others feelings before speaking
Be truthful - after awhile no one believes you if you tell lies
Talk when there is a problem - Use words when you are angry
No bullying of other youth or staff
Cooperate with adult supervisor - Don't argue
Take responsibility for your own behavior

2. The Youth Activities Program is a safe place

Keep your hands and feet to yourself - No fighting - hitting, kicking or pushing
Play games and use equipment safely
No threats of physical harm
No physical or verbal intimidation

3. We will take care of the building, our equipment, and our surroundings

Treat the pool table and all other equipment carefully
Computers are to be handled gently
Be careful not to damage floors, walls, etc.
Dogs are allowed in the basement only. The dog's owner is responsible for the dog's behavior and any messes the dog makes.
Check with an adult before getting out art supplies
Don't go upstairs without specific permission from the adult supervisor-always ask and adult to use the bathroom - only one youth can go up at a time
When we play in the gym the stage is off limits
Treat the building and grounds with respect

4. There will be consequences for behaving badly

Consequences will include being asked to leave for the day and may include indefinite suspension of the privilege of participating in the program.

If a participant is found breaking the law (for example: smoking, or using alcohol or illegal drugs), the sheriff's office and the child's parents will be notified. The child's participation privileges may be revoked.
