Job Description:

- Deliver parent child engagement classes for children ages 0-5 to build literacy skills and prepare them to enter kindergarten.
 - LIFT classes will be offered two times a week, in 3 sessions related to the school year. (Oct-Dec) (Jan-Mar) (April-June)
 - Encourage positive parent-child interactions and learning together through playtime, storytime, arts and crafts, and music activities.
 - Provides guidance to any community volunteers assisting with the program
 - Promotes parent and child connections with local Kindergarten programs
 - Provides guidance to parents to support early learning in the group and at home
 - Identify any homeless children and connect with the HELP Program Coordinator.
 - Serve at least 10 children (ages 0-5) and 10 parents/caregivers per session.
 - Keep sign-in sheets for each LIFT class.
 - Set up, clean up, recruitment and outreach.
 - Complete LIFT evaluation and reports for each child and parent participating in LIFT. Turn in to LCSD Early Learning Coordinator no later than two weeks following the end of the LIFT session.
 - LIFT Facilitators participate in quarterly LIFT coordination meetings with Early Learning Coordinator
- Attend professional development and training opportunities as requested by Early Learning Coordinator.
